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HB 167 amends AS 29.45.650 and AS 29.45.700 to add a new subsection to protect "specie" from a borough sales or use tax on the sale as well as from city sales or use tax on the sale or exchange of a specie. This legislation would direct the House Finance Committee to study and prepare legislation should it determine that any future alternative form of tender is practical and beneficial as a recognized medium of exchange for the payment of debts.
