- RurAL CAP is the only Community Action Agency in Alaska






Our Mission



To empower low-income Alaskans through advocacy, education, affordable housing, and direct services that respect our unique values and cultures.








Statewide Impact

During 2021, RurAL CAP employed 502 Alaskans in 57 communities statewide.



Statewide Impact

FY 2021 Highlights:

- 233 adults and 315 children received transitional or affordable housing
- 125 families' homes were weatherized
- 22 Tribes received training and technical assistance through the Alaska Tribal Justice Resource Center
- 639 children were enrolled in Early Head Start and Head Start programs
