FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

/
The legislation provides a pathway for alternative teacher certification. School districts would be allowed to establish paraprofessional training programs designed to prepare high school students for entry into a registered teacher apprenticeship program. A new teacher resident certificate is also established through the Department of Education and Early Development which would be valid for one school year with the possibility for a two-year renewal.
This legislation establishes the Teachers Registered Apprenticeship Program fund. The fund consists of money appropriated to it by the legislature and the department may spend from the fund without further appropriation for the program purposes outlined in the bill.
The cost of the apprenticeship is borne by the employer with support from the United States Department of Labor (USDOL) through grants. The Alaska Workforce Investment Board (AWIB) has an apprenticeship coordinator, whose workload would not be significantly impacted by the creation of this program. The school districts would develop the program requirements in consultation with AWIB. The approval would rest with USDOL.
There is no fiscal impact to the department.
