

## House Bill 416 Sponsor Statement — Version A

"An Act relating to the compensation of certain executive branch employees not covered by collective bargaining agreements; and providing for an effective date."

House Bill 416 creates a temporary act amending uncodified law to provide for policy mandated one-time bonuses for nonunion state employees identified in the FY2023 Operating Budget appropriation bill. Funding for House Bill 461 is included in House Bill 281.

On April 9, 2022, the House of Representatives passed House Bill 218—the FY2023 Operating Budget—which included appropriations for the purpose of providing retention bonuses to specific types of positions in the Department of Law (Criminal Division and Civil Division), the Public Defender Agency, and the Office of Public Advocacy. House Bill 281 now goes to the Senate for consideration.
