STATE OF ALASKA 2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 402

Analysis

HB 402 acknowledges the use of the internet as a means to identify a contractor or home inspector. Current statutes require all advertisements to show contractor's or home inspector's name, mailing address, address of the their principal place of business and their registration number. HB 402 would allow the use of a web address or landing site in advertisements instead. The website would contain the required information including the contractor's or home inspector's name, mailing address, and address of the principal place of business.
The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are primarily funded by Receipt Supported Services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065 so the total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
