**EXPLANATION OF CHANGES**  
*HB 392: EXPAND ADV. PRAC. REG. NURSE AUTHORITY*

**CSHB 392(HSS) to CSHB 392(HSS) am Version 32-LS1561/B.A**

**Section 5:**

*Page 3, line 5:*

Adds “with the written consent of the patient or the parent or guardian of the patient if the patient is under 18 years old” to language regarding the issuance of a do-not-resuscitate order.

**HB 392 to CSHB 392(HSS) - Version 32-LS1561/B**

*HB 392 as originally written only expanded signature authority for POLST, DNRs, and Death Certificates to APRNs. It was then amended to include Physician Assistants.*

**Sections 1-2:**

Adds “physician assistant” to language in AS.08.68.700(a) Determination of death by registered nurse to allow a Registered Nurse (RN) to pronounce or determine a death of a person if a physician, advanced practice registered nurse (APRN), or a physician assistant (PA) has:

- Documented that the person’s death was anticipated; or
- The RN had prior written authorization from a physician, PA, or APRN

**Sections 3-4:**

Adds language and conforming changes authorizing PAs to certify a death in addition to APRNs and Physicians.

**Section 5-10:**

Adds language authorizing PAs to issue or revoke a Do Not Resuscitate order in addition to APRNs and Physicians. It also makes conforming changes to ensure PAs are subject to the same standard policies and protocols.

**Section 11:**

Adds “physician assistants” to the Advanced Health Care Directive Form.

**Section 12-14:**

Adds “physician assistants” to relevant definitions.

**Section 15:**

Authorizes physician assistants to sign a death certificate. Defines physician assistant as an individual licensed under *AS 08.64.107 Regulation of Physician Assistants and Intensive Care Paramedics*.
