### House Bill 132 – Summary of Changes Version N to Version F

#### Version N to Version R

On April 11, 2022, the Senate Education Committee adopted CS HB 132 (EDU) version R, which deleted the refundable registered apprentice tax credit of \$1250 for the first year of employment. In addition, the CS added a section that creates a report to the legislature that parallels the middle college reporting requirement in SB 32. In addition, in Section 4 of version N, the CS reinserted a section from Version B of HB 132 that allows a school district to contract with agencies for dual credit CTE programs, available to high school students. These programs include vocational education, pre-apprenticeship, apprenticeship, work-based learning, and on-the-job experience programs. An additional section, now Section 6, was added to designate that both the Department of Education and the Department of Labor & Workforce Development have a duty to support school districts offering concurrent CTE programs.

#### Version R to Version F

On April 20, 2022, the Senate Education Committee amended Version R of the bill to incorporate three amendments. Amendment #1 defined “relative” as “a child’s mother, mother-in-law, father, father-in-law, sister, sister-in-law, brother, brother-in-law, grandparent, aunt, or uncle”. Amendment #3 deleted completing eighth grade as a requirement for a student to be eligible to participate in a concurrent career and technical education programs. Amendment #4 changed the title to include an act “relating to awarding course credit for activities outside of school hours” and allows for a 14 year old or older to receive course credit from activity outside of school hours that meets educational or physical activity requirements. SCS CS HB 132 (EDU) version F is the result of these amendments, and is the document before the Senate Labor & Commerce Committee.
