Summary of Changes Version B CSHB 226 (STA) to Version C CSHB 226 (FIN)

- **Section 1 of version C** amends the base salary schedule in AS 39.27.011(a) for state employees who are not members of a collective bargaining agreement. Salaries in this section are increased by 5% from 2015 amounts.
- **Section 2 of version C** is identical to section 1 of version B.
- **Section 3 of version C** changes section 2 of version B in the following ways:
 - Adjusts additional pay increase- on July 1, 2023- for state attorneys from 10 percent to 15 percent.
 - Removes reference to AS 39.27.011 (e) and (f) (sections referencing pay increases that occurred in 2014 and 2015)
 - Ensures inclusion of legislative attorneys.
 - Creates a new subsection (m) stipulating that future pay increases for exempt and partially exempt employees will occur in parallel to negotiated pay increases approved for the supervisory unit.
- **Section 4 of version C** repeals AS 39.27.011 (e) and (f) (sections referencing pay increases that occurred in 2014 and 2015).
- **Section 5 of version C** adds uncodified language to include exempt officers and employees of the executive branch in the 5 percent pay increase under AS 39.27.011(a).
- **Section 6 of version C** adds uncodified language to include judicial branch employees in the pay 5 percent increase under AS 39.27.011(a). Additionally stipulates that judicial branch employees, excluding justices and judges, will receive an additional 10% pay increase on July 1, 2023.
- **Section 7 of version C** adds uncodified language to include certain exempt employees of the University in the 5 percent pay increase under AS 39.27.011(a).
- **Section 8 of version C** mirrors Section 3 of version B.
- **Section 9 of version C** mirrors Section 4 of version B and renumbers section references accordingly.
- **Section 10 of version C** mirrors Section 5 of version B and renumbers section references accordingly.
