FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB073

Analysis

This legislation would require the department to notify a complainant and give the complainant 10 days to object before closing an investigation conducted under the section based on a complaint.

Under current policies, complainants receive a letter upon closure of an investigation. The letter advises the complainant that the case is closed, if appropriate action or no action was taken by the board or division (depending on the program), and thanking them for contacting the division.

The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.

Investigative costs in the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing are funded by General Fund (fund source 1004 Gen Fund (UGF)).
