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

 - Removal of downhole completion equipment
 - Perforations
 - Install new partial sand control
 - Increase Production for Winter 2023-2024 +





Summer 2023 Well Work Risks and Uncertainties

- Cost uncertainty, duration of work
 - Mobilization of new rig to Cook Inlet
 - Packer removal difficulties/sand
 - Lost circulation
 - Weather impacts, especially later in season
- Screen plugging / filter sizing
- Downhole equipment arrival times
- Contractor Risk
- Delays and cost in materials & shipping

- Release Seismic Data Early


Many entities no longer operate in Alaska

- Accelerate Permitting Process




