Developing a natural burial site, flameless cremation, and the Alaska End of Life Alliance, a nonprofit focused on end-of-life care



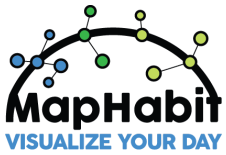
An app to coordinate communication for senior care. Included in the Alaska Caregivers Guide developed by the Alaska Dementia Action Collaborative.



An app to improve communication and care for those with Behavioral Health needs. A second phase of the project, led by High Utilizers Mat-Su (HUMS) has recently received funding and the project will broadly launch in 2023.



A safety system for frontline healthcare workers. They are in discussions with partners in Fairbanks, Anchorage, and Homer.



A platform for increasing independence with Fairbanks, Anchorage, and Homer. A pilot project is in development with the Alaska Association of Developmental Disabilities, Stone Soup Group, and the Anchorage School District.



A virtual platform for licensing supervision for therapists and counselors. Now available for social workers and therapists. Working on adding doctoral level licensing.



A data and biometrics company improving Medication Assisted Treatment for Substance Use Disorder. A Mat-Su based pilot project is expected in 2023.



An alcohol misuse management app. They are working with Recover Alaska, Alaska Behavioral Health, and Anchorage Neighborhood Health Center.



A mobile and telehealth business providing occupational therapy care to seniors throughout Alaska. Now available and onboarding clients.



Specialized visual programming for those with Alzheimers and dementia. Integrated into Alzheimer's Resource of Alaska educational services.
