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Analysis

This bill adds "associate counselor" as a licensed profession under AS 08.29.
This bill directs the Board of Professional Counselors to stipulate – through regulations – the criteria for associate counselor licensure; the types of associate counselor programs that are authorized for licensure; and the criteria for supervisor certification.
The Division of Behavioral Health and the Division of Health Care Services, located within the Department of Health, are submitting a zero dollar Medicaid Services fiscal note for this bill. The department does not have estimates for the number of individuals in Alaska that will become or are currently eligible to be licensed associate counselors. This fiscal note assumes that the Medicaid costs from the associate counselor license are currently contemplated within the department's current Medicaid services budget.
Both the Division of Behavioral Health and the Division of Health Care services will need to promulgate regulations related to the onboarding of this new license type.
