Analysis

This bill amends AS 14.17.910(a) by adding language that a district will need to make financial information on the receipt and distribution of state aid, money required from local effort, and any other money received or held by the district accessible on an internet website to the public at no cost. A provision is included that the district will need to make financial information available on the internet website available for each school in the district.

There is no fiscal impact to the Department of Education and Early Development under this bill.
