Notes: "Unavailable" means that the respondent was unable to locate that years' data, either because of staff turnover or changes in reporting software utilized by DOL&WD resulted in an inability for respondents to locate historic data. "Not provided" indicates that the respondent did not provide any data for that year. Shaded rows indicate that data is maintained on a calendar, rather than a fiscal, year. **TVEP** figures represent 40% fund recipients. Numbers in red represent a change in Department of Labor & Workforce Development (DOL&WD) reporting methodology. In 2016, DOL&WD began reporting numbers of students served by a program in that year, rather than the number of students exiting the program in that year.

STEP figures represent 44% of STEP-funded organizations, not including the University system.

ACA: Only two of the eight (25%) organizations identified by the DOL&WD as ACA providers responded to our requests for information.

- 1) University of Alaska and NACTEC data pulled from Alaska Workforce Investment Board (AWIB) reports, rather than from the sources themselves.
- 2) Data for FY13 and FY14 represent partial numbers because the respondent was unable to locate all the records.
- 3) Data includes both long and short-term AVTEC students.
- 4) NACTEC respondent advised us that he believes that AWIB data is accurate, except that FY12 - FY13 include both secondary and post-secondary students.
- 5) FY23 is Alaska CHARR's first year receiving STEP funds and the data provided is for enrollment through December 2022.
- 6) Alaska Hospital & Healthcare Association began receiving STEP grants in FY17.
