Sectional Analysis

House Bill 120: HUNT/FISH LICENSE FOR NONRESIDENT STUDENT

"An Act relating to hunting, trapping, and fishing licenses for certain nonresident postsecondary students; and providing for an effective date."

Section 1: Amends the section to include the new nonresident postsecondary student license.

Section 2: Adds a new subsection allowing for nonresident students who are enrolled half-time or part-time in postsecondary education to purchase a special nonresident postsecondary student license for sport fishing, hunting, or trapping at the same cost as a resident license.

Section 3: Provides uncodified law that allows the Department of Fish and Game to adopt regulations to implement to the new license.
