Why this fiscal note differs from previous version/comments:

The fiscal note analysis differs from the previous version in that the Committee Substitute adds an additional \$348 to the base student allocation (BSA) making it \$7,308 in FY2025. Additionally, in FY2026 the BSA would be increased based on the preceding four calendar year average change in the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers for urban Alaska.

FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. CSSB 52

Analysis

SB52 will increase the base student allocation (BSA), under AS 14.17.470, by \$1,000 in the public school funding formula. The BSA will change from \$5,960 to \$6,960 in FY2024 resulting in a \$257 million increase in funding to school districts. The BSA will increase an additional \$348 in FY2025 from \$6,960 to \$7,308. The Department of Education and Early Development (DEED) is instructed to apply a Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment to the BSA in FY2026 by taking the average of the preceding four calendar years of the CPI for all urban consumers (CPI-U) in Alaska.
For the purposes of developing a fiscal note, the FY2026 CPI-U average is estimated to be 4.50%.
This legislation also states that DEED shall collaborate with the Department of Labor and Workforce Development (DLWD) on gathering data on each high school graduating class in a district by collecting post-high school data on each student every five years for 20 years after the high school graduation date of the class.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2023 (FY2024).
