**RE: ANTHC Support of House Bill 112**

Representative Ruffridge,

On behalf of the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC), I write in support of House Bill (HB) 112.

ANTHC is a statewide tribal health organization serving all 229 Tribes and all Alaska Native and American Indian (AN/AI) individuals in Alaska. ANTHC and Southcentral Foundation co-manage the Alaska Native Medical Center (ANMC), the tertiary care hospital for all AN/AI people in Alaska. ANTHC also provides a wide range of statewide public health, community health, environmental health and other programs and services for Alaska Native people and their communities.

HB 112 would align the Alaska Board of Pharmacy's statutes with those from other states, providing needed updates to reflect current pharmacy services and activities, including licensing and oversight of out-of-state pharmacies, outsourcing facilities, and internet pharmacies providing services in Alaska. The bill also allows the Board of Pharmacy to implement a national criminal background check for Alaska pharmacists and pharmacy technicians, critical to maintaining the security of our pharmacies and the safety of our patients.
