FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 116

Analysis

The bill amends Alaska Statute (AS) 43.23.048(b) as it relates to appropriations from the restorative justice account. The bill increases the allocation for nonprofit organizations to provide grants for services for crime victims and domestic violence and sexual assault programs from one to three percent to 79 to 88 percent. It reduces the allocation for the Department of Corrections from 79 to 88 percent, to one to three percent.

The Department of Public Safety (DPS), Council of Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault receives and dispenses state and federal money and awards grants and contracts from appropriations to qualified local community entities for domestic violence, sexual assault, and crisis intervention and prevention programs. The increase in funding will be applied to these programs, as well as robust advertising campaigns, with an emphasis on prevention.

FY2024 funding is based on current FY2024 budgeted Restorative Justice funds for the Department of Corrections, less the current FY2024 budgeted Restorative Justice Funds for DPS. (\$19,836.5 - \$502.2 = \$19,334.3). The FY2024 fund is high, since the permanent fund was \$2,622 and the energy relief payment was \$662, both of which were transferred into the Restorative Justice Fund.

FY2025 through FY2029 are based on the fund source change based on the distribution for that year, less the new distribution percentage set forth in this legislation. Given the large fluctuations in available Restorative Justice funding from year to year, out year costs are simply based on an average distribution from the last five years.
