FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB 43

Analysis

This bill seeks to amend existing health education law, AS 14.30.360 by requiring schools to provide a program in health and personal safety education for kindergarten through grade 12 that includes comprehensive sex education. The bill requires sexual health education to be included in the program and outlines what must be taught as part of the comprehensive sexual health curriculum. Lastly, the bill adds a reporting requirement to the Department of Education & Early Development (DEED) for districts to report at the school level a summary and evaluation of the curriculum.

This fiscal note contains three one-time, multi-year expenses: 1) \$30.0 for \$1.5 stipends for 20 parents and qualified stakeholders for their year long participation in the research and authoring of the standards, 2) \$35.0 contract for a national Personal Safety Health Education expert to facilitate the standards process and professional development materials, and 3) \$6.0 for legal fees to implement the necessary regulation changes.

DEED plans to hold the necessary stakeholder engagement meetings with participating stakeholders virtually and to publish and disseminate the new health education/sexual health standards electronically.

Transition language provides the State Board of Education and Early Development two years to develop health and personal safety guidelines. A multi-year appropriation of \$71.0 covering FY2024 and FY2025 would allow the department to expend funding over the two years.

This bill would take effect June 30, 2024.
