## **Analysis**

This is a bill that will add anti-discrimination language against the State of Israel into Title 36 (Public Contracts) Chapter 90 (Miscellaneous Provisions) and require public contract agencies to include an anti-discrimination clause in those contracts. The Office of Procurement and Property Management anticipates some additional staff time to incorporate and educate public agencies on the new bill, should it become law, but believes the agency can absorb the cost of these efforts in the existing budget. Accordingly, Office of Procurement and Property Management submits a zero fiscal note. Implementation and changes to policies expected to be finalized within 180 days after passage.
