If the commissioner determines that a district does not meet those requirements, the commissioner shall advise the district of the determination and deduct that amount from state aid paid to the district for the current fiscal year. A deduction in state aid required under this subsection begins with the payment for the second full month after the determination, unless a waiver has been granted by the board under (d) of this section.
- (d) A district that the commissioner determines to be out of compliance with the requirements of this section may, within 20 days after the commissioner's determination, request from the board a waiver from the imposition by the commissioner of a deduction in state aid payments under (b) or (c) of this section. The request must be in writing and must provide an explanation of the reasons for which the district is unable to comply with the requirements of this section. The district shall also submit the request to the Legislative Budget and Audit Committee. The Legislative Budget and Audit Committee shall review the district's request and forward its recommendations on the request to the board. The board may grant the waiver if the board determines that the district's failure to meet the expenditure requirements of this section is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the district.
- (e) The commissioner shall submit an annual report on actions taken by the commissioner or the board under this section to the Legislative Budget and Audit
