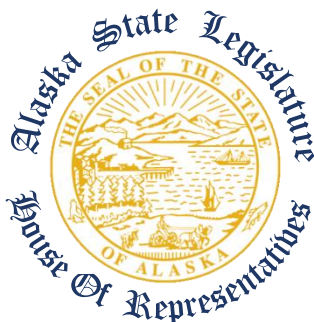

House Joint Resolution 3

Summary of Changes between Ver B and Ver S

“Encouraging Congress to pass the Concealed Carry Reciprocity Act or a Similar Bill.”

House Judiciary CS for HJR 3 changes the following:

Page 1, Line 15: removes the language “a person who is 21 years of age or older and”

Page 2, Line 6: removes “recognized” and replaces it with the language “proved, and the effect thereof,”

Page 2, Lines 18-21: remove all language after “United States Congress pass legislation that” and inserts “determines the manner in which a concealed carry permit issued by one state may be proven in another state, so that an individual in possession of a valid permit may lawfully carry a concealed firearm in another state in the same manner, and to the same degree, that an individual in possession of a valid concealed carry permit from that other state may legally do so; and be it”

Page 2, Line 24: inserts the language “a bill that accomplishes this, such as”

Page 2, Lines 27, 28: after “passed by Congress,” removes the language “that enacts the Concealed Carry Reciprocity Act (H.R. 38) from the 117th Congress or a similar bill” and inserts “that accomplishes this, such as the Concealed Carry Reciprocity Act (H.R. 38) from the 117th Congress or a similar bill.”
