

Percentage of Students with Access to a Local Charter School, by State in 2014-15









Figure 1: Academic Growth Rates for Poor and Non-Poor Students by State, 2008-2018 (Source: Stanford Educational Opportunity Project)




Ohio school districts by open-enrollment status: 2017-2018 school year
