The ANSEP high schools are in Anchorage, Palmer, Bethel, and Kotzebue with additional schools starting up in Dillingham and Juneau. A residential high school has started up on the University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA) campus. Students without access to one of these locations come to Anchorage during the summer and take the course work they need so that they do not require remediation when they start college. The ANSEP's goal is to provide an excellent education and a life of unlimited possibilities for every Alaskan. Students at each education level benefit from the inspiration, guidance, and opportunity the program provides. With ANSEP, more students are successful, fewer students drop out, and remediation is eliminated

The ANSEP received \$9.5 million of federal COVID relief funds through the Department of Education and Early Development (DEED) to assist with expansion and institutionalization of the program. This \$4 million increase, in addition to the \$1 million requested in the FY2024 Governor's budget, for a total of \$5 million to ANSEP, will provide additional funding stream to support the Acceleration Academy High School expansion.

Supporting and maintaining this program meets DEED's mission and several of the goals from Alaska's Education Challenge.
