FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

Analysis

This bill creates the Alaska Sunset Commission and outlines the duties, expectations, and enforcement capacity for that Commission. The costs of creating, supporting, and maintaining a commission of this stature is difficult to predict. The necessary considerations to determine the costs will include the scope of work, the number and type of support staff required to support the Commission, the frequency of meetings, and the findings of the Commission which are expected to vary from year to year as the Commission reviews different Departments.
The nearest approximation to determine a cost estimate at this time would be the Alaska Public Office Commission (APOC), which is currently housed in the Department of Administration. APOC is smaller than the proposed Alaska Sunset Commission in terms of required commissioners and requires 9 support staff in addition to the costs of operating the Commission. The FY2024 operating budget of APOC is approximately \$1.1 million.
Given the increased size of the Alaska Sunset Commission, unknown scope of work, unknown nature of the findings, and the need for implementation and enforcement of the findings, the Department estimates the cost of the Alaska Sunset Commission to be approximately \$1.6 million for the first year of operating expenditures.
