6	AS 12.47.110 without the defendant's informed consent if the court finds that
7	(1) the defendant presents a substantial danger of physical injury to
8	self or to other persons and treatment is in the defendant's medical interest; or
9	(2) the administration of psychotropic medication
10	(A) serves an important governmental interest that is
11	significantly furthered by the administration of psychotropic medication;
12	(B) is necessary to further the important governmental interest
13	and a less intrusive treatment is unlikely to achieve the same result;
14	(C) is medically appropriate for the defendant;
15	(D) is substantially unlikely to have side effects that will
16	significantly interfere with the defendant's ability to assist counsel in
17	presenting a defense; and
18	(E) is substantially likely to render the defendant competent to
19	stand trial.
20	(b) In this section, "important governmental interest" means the state's interest
21	in bringing to trial a defendant accused of a serious crime."
