



HB 60 Explanation of Changes Version “A” to Version “S.A”

Section 1	This language is unchanged from section 1 of version <i>A</i> .
Section 2	Version <i>S</i> includes the newly identified need to include the Department of Family and Community Services in the definition of department.
Section 3	This language is unchanged from section 2 of version <i>A</i> .
Section 4	This language is unchanged from section 3 of version <i>A</i> .
Sections 5-10 and 12-15	Version <i>S</i> updated these sections to further clarify the duties of each department related to programs for runaways. Section 8 was amended on the floor of the House of Representatives to require facilities licensed as runaway shelters to make reports of suspected human and sex trafficking to a law enforcement agency and provide information to minors about human and sex trafficking and the services available to victims. A new section was added to include the definition of human trafficking.
Section 11	Version <i>S</i> updates the bill to include a necessary clarification related to the confidentiality of records related to shelters for runaways.
Section 16	This language is unchanged from section 10 of version <i>A</i> .
Section 17	Version <i>S</i> amends this section to replace the term “authorizing” with “applicable” from section 11 of version <i>A</i> . This change reflects the removal of the definition for the term “authorizing” in section 20 below.
Sections 18-19	This language is unchanged from sections 12-13 of version <i>A</i> .
Section 20	This language is unchanged from section 14 of version <i>A</i> .
Section 21	Version <i>S</i> amends Section 15 from version <i>A</i> to remove the new definition for “authorizing department” to avoid potential confusion with the duplicate definition of “applicable department.”
Section 22	Version <i>S</i> moves the repeal of this language related to the licensure of shelters for runaways from Section 9 in version <i>A</i> . AS 47.32.010 was repealed and reenacted under Executive Order 121, section 79.
Section 23	This language is unchanged from section 16 of version <i>A</i> .
