Analysis

This bill amends statutes pertaining to the military and definitions of "armed forces" to add the "United States Space Force". The Department of Defense established the United States Space Force as a unique and distinct branch of the armed forces on December 20, 2019, when the National Defense Authorization Act was signed into law.
This bill amends AS 24.20.650(b)(3)(B), adding Space Force to existing Air Force member of the Joint Armed Services Committee state resident considerations for public members of the committee. It also amends AS 26.05.385(d)(1), adds Space Force to the identified branches of service listed for eligible certified or designated judge advocate members must be active or reserve members of under the code of military justice. Additionally, it amends AS 26.30.900(3)(A), adding Space Force to the list of branches defining facilities in the statute relating to military facility zones.
This bill will have no fiscal impact to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, therefore, a zero fiscal note is submitted.
