1 **"An Act establishing June 9 of each year as Don Young Day."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:

4 **Sec. 44.12.185. Don Young Day.** Don Young Day is established on June 9 of
5 each year to honor Don Young, whose long record of public service includes 49 years
6 as the United States House of Representatives member from Alaska, for his service to
7 the state and the nation. Don Young Day may be observed by suitable observances and
8 exercises by civil groups and the public.
