# STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO.	SB 101
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## **Analysis**

Senate Bill 101 requests that the Alaska Energy Authority (AEA), submit a report to the Senate Secretary and Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and notify the legislature that the report is available the first day of the first regular session of each legislature. The report must identify the authority's progress in developing renewable energy resources in rural regions of the state, evaluate renewable energy resource development in rural regions, identify infrastructure necessary for rural renewable energy projects, and evaluate the feasibility of cost of rural renewable energy projects.

The bill sets an effective date of July 1, 2023.

## **Cost Assumptions:**

Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority (AIDEA) provides all staff support for AEA programs and is reimbursed via a reimbursable services agreement from AEA. See related fiscal note for the Alaska Energy Authority. Through AIDEA, AEA is requesting two new positions, a Program Manager and a Analyst Programmer that will be required in order to generate the report. AEA will the pay contractual costs to AIDEA for these two new positions.
