FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation would make Alaska a member state of the Audiology and Speech-Language Interstate Compact (ASLP-IC or "compact"), which would allow Alaska's audiologists (AUDs) and speech-language pathologists (SLPs) with unencumbered licenses who have had no adverse action against their license within two years to apply for and work under compact privilege in any other member states; and would allow the same for AUDs and SLPs meeting the same requirements in Alaska.

If this bill passes a long-term non-permanent Administrative Assistant 1 (AA1) would be required to assist with processing fingerprint cards and other administrative tasks. It is anticipated that this position would be required for approximately six months.

If the bill passes the following expenses will be incurred:

Personal Services: FY25 only: \$37.8 for 1 long term non-permanent Admin Assistant 1 (R12)

Services: FY24 only: \$2.5 (printing, postage, and legal costs for regulations project to conform

with statutory changes)

FY25 only: \$25.0 for core services charges

Commodities: FY25 only: \$10.0 for one-time set up costs

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services (fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF)). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065. The total amount of revenue collected approximately equals each occupation's actual regulatory costs.

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
