BILL NO. CSHB068(JUD)

Analysis

HB68CS (JUD) makes conviction of crimes under AS 11.41.340 – 11.41.355 (created by this Act) an offense that prohibits an individual from qualifying for certain professional licenses or qualifying for renewal of such professional licenses. This legislation allows the department to revoke such professional licenses for life in the event of such a conviction. It also requires individuals holding these professional licenses to notify the department if they've been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor. The professions this applies to are Athletic Trainers, Private Professional Guardians and Conservators, Professional Counselors, Massage Therapists, Martial and Family Therapists, Physicians, Osteopathic Physicians, Podiatrists, Physician Assistants, Direct-Entry Midwives, Registered Nurses, Practical Nurses, Pharmacists, Psychologists, Psychological Associates, and Clinical Social Workers.

The Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services (fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF)). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065. The total amount of revenue collected approximately equals each occupation's actual regulatory costs.
