Official Business

CS for Senate Bill 52: Base Student Allocation Changes from Education Committee version ("S" to "R")

Two main changes:

- 1) Page 8, line 7. Increases the Base Student Allocation by \$680, from \$5,960 to \$6,640, for FY2024 (effective July 1, 2023).
- 2) Removed subsequent year increases to the BSA that were in the Education Committee version.

What the bill still does:

 Retains the changes made in Senate Education that add new reporting and "dashboard" requirements to better track academic performance and the progress of each high school graduating class. These are amended into the existing requirements created by the Alaska Reads Act in 2022.
