BILL NO. SB 141

Analysis

SB 141 directs the designation of the bridge at Wood River (Bridge #1902), between Dillingham and Aleknagik, as the Raymond and Esther Conquest Bridge under AS 35.40. DOT&PF estimates the 2 signs that would be installed after passage of this legislation will be placed, one on each end of the bridge, at an estimated cost of \$11k for each sign, \$22k total (below detail in actual dollars).
