FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill will increase the base student allocation (BSA), under AS 14.17.470, by \$680 in the public school funding formula. The BSA will change from \$5,960 to \$6,640 in FY2024, resulting in a \$174,886,368 projected increase in funding to school This bill also states that the Department of Education and Early Development shall collaborate with the Department of Labor and Workforce Development on gathering data on each high school graduating class in a district by collecting posthigh school data on each student every five years for 20 years after the high school graduation date of the class. These provisions take effect July 1, 2023 (FY2024). The funding mechanism is a general fund transfer to the Public Education Fund (PEF). The fiscal note effect for FY2024 through FY2029 is reported in the fiscal note for the PEF, as the funding is deposited to the PEF, not into the Foundation Program funding component.
