HB-279

“An Act relating to the Local Boundary Commission”

Section 1.

AS 44.33.810

Lines 10 – 12 (new language)

Establishes that at least one Local Boundary Commissioner be from the unorganized Borough.

Requires a commissioner appointed from a Judicial District to be domiciled and registered to vote in that District.

Allows the Governor to name any Commissioner appointed as Chair.

Section 2.

AS 44.33.812 (a)

Lines 17-20

Adds a new subsection (5)

Requires the commission to keep up to date census records for all Alaska communities.

Sec. 3

AS 44.33.812

Line 21.

Establishes an effective date clause to coincide with the next open seat on the commission.
