BILL NO. SB 68	
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Analysis

This bill modernizes public notice procedures by eliminating requirements to publish notices in newspapers, in favor of providing public notice on the Alaska Online Public Notice System, by mail, and by other means as deemed necessary. The changes would apply to public notices relating to the sale, appropriation, or removal of water, and for the commencement of the process for determining the rights of persons to appropriations of water.				
The Department requires the applicant to pay the costs of public notice required in these two statutes. Regulation 11 AAC 93.080 references publication in a newspaper and will need to be changed, but those costs will be handled with existing budget authority.				
The Division of Mining, Land and Water does not anticipate incurring any additional costs.
