15 completed an alcohol server education course under AS 04.21.025 delivers the
16 distilled spirits from the licensed premises to the purchaser at the location designated
17 under (3) of this subsection and requires the purchaser to provide identification and
18 acceptable proof of age under AS 04.21.050(b);

19 (3) the holder designates a parking place less than 225 feet from an
20 entry to the distillery retail licensed premises for pickup of distilled spirits;
