Analysis

	This legislation will prohibit providers from treating individuals under 18 or vulnerable adults with therapies or regimens that seek to change the individual's sexual orientation or gender identity, and requires a person required to report to report violations of this law. This legislation adds violations of this new law to grounds for discipline or sanctions against a professional license issued under AS 08.
	Investigative costs in the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing are dependent on the number and type of complaints received. The division does not know the number of complaints that may be received and so the fiscal impact of this legislation cannot be determined at this time.
	Investigative costs in FY2024 are funded by General Fund (fund source 1004 Gen Fund (UGF)).
