FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB361

Analysis

House Bill 361 proposes alignment of Alaska Medicaid mental health and substance use disorder benefits with federal requirements. This bill requires the Department of Health (DOH) to comply with the requirements for mental health or substance use disorder benefit requirements, codified under 26 U.S.C. 9812, 29 U.S.C. 1185a, and 42 U.S.C.300gg-26 and for the DOH to submit Medicaid state plan amendments, as necessary, for the approval by the United States Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS).

This bill amends AS 47.07.030 by adding a new subsection to align the state's health benefit provision with federal requirements, namely 26 U.S.C. 9812, 29 U.S.C. 1185a, and 42 U.S.C. 300gg-26, to ensure parity in mental health and substance use disorder benefits.

This bill amends the uncodified law of the State of Alaska by adding a new section: Medicaid State Plan. The Department of Health is to submit necessary documentation to the DHHS for approval to amend the state plan under AS 47.07.040.

The following are areas where state health benefit provisions need to align with the summary of U.S.C. key requirements:

- 1) Group Health Plan/Health Insurance Issuer Requirements
- 2) Financial Requirements
- 3) Treatment Limitations
- 4) Nonquantitative Treatment Limitations
- 5) Plan Information
- 6) Out of Network Providers
- 7) Exemptions 3

The bill as written will not affect reimbursement rates or change the occurrence or frequency of claims processing. The costs to amend the state plan will be absorbed by the department. As a result, a zero fiscal note is submitted.
