BILL NO. HB 382

Analysis

House Bill 382 directs school districts and local school boards to create policies and procedures for parents' rights regarding their student's education, rights of teachers, and school records. Each school district will be required to assemble an Academic Policy Committee.

This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).

There is a one-time cost to the department of \$6.0 for the creation of regulations with the Department of Law.
