FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 19A

Analysis

This bill removes the requirement for commercial vessels with US Coast Guard documentation and a license issued under Title 16 to register under AS 05.25.055. It then adds a section to AS 16.05.475 requiring a \$8 registration fee payable to the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission (CFEC) for the same vessels.

There is a minimal administrative impact to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR). DNR's Abandoned and Derelict Vessel (ADV) Program contacts vessel owners if their vessel becomes an ADV. To find and verify ownership information staff contact the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to obtain registration information. By removing the DMV registration requirement for commercial fishing vessels, the ADV Program would have to obtain ownership information through the CFEC. If the vessel is not up to date with CFEC licensing, and not yet registered with the DMV, the ADV Program would have to verify the ownership information through Coast Guard documentation at a cost of \$25. Though more cumbersome for determining the legal owner as defined by AS 30.30.170(4), few vessels become abandoned and derelict therefore the Department anticipates minimal fiscal impact for verifying ownership and therefore, the Division submits a zero fiscal note.
