This legislation increases the penalty when a person distributes a controlled substance and a person dies as a result of ingesting the substance from a class A felony to an unclassified felony. It also establishes a new set of statutes specifically for vehicular homicide. Aggravated vehicular homicide (unclassified felony) will include conduct where a person operates a motor vehicle under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, vehicular homicide (class A felony) will include conduct where a person operates a motor vehicle and recklessly causes the death of another, and negligent vehicular homicide (class B felony) will include conduct where a person operates a motor vehicle and negligently causes the death of another person.

While the Criminal Division may see some increase in litigation due to the increased penalties for homicides that occur due to drug distribution, it anticipates that it will be able to absorb this additional work within its existing budget. Similarly, the Criminal Division does not anticipate a fiscal impact from the establishment of the vehicular homicide offense series as these types of cases are already routinely handled and prosecuted by the Criminal Division. The creation of the vehicular

homicide offense series does not create a new crime but more adequately describes the conduct at issue and clarifies the
