



Summary of Changes

From SB211 \A to CS for SB211(L&C) \B

The Senate Labor & Commerce Committee changes as reflected in version \B are:

Overall: Adopts revisions recommended by Legislative Legal Services to conform the bill with legislative drafting standards; additional conforming changes accommodate substantive CS changes.

Removed: Removes a significant bill component expanding the procurement preference for in-state agricultural and fisheries products bought by state agencies and by school districts and municipalities that receive state funding. This change removes 13 sections as the original bill expanded the preference for 5 years, reverting to current statute at the end of that period.

New: **Section 2, page 2, lines 9-10 and 23-24:** Includes in-state manufacturing of food or animal feed to the activities eligible for Agriculture Revolving Loan Fund loans.

Section 3, page 3, lines 15-19: Instead of eliminating the statutory maximum in loans to one person and having the Board of Agriculture and Conservation set a limit in regulation, increases the statutory cap from \$1 million to \$3 million and enables annual inflation adjustments to the cap. Removes a requirement for a first priority security for certain loans, reverting to current statute requiring first priority security only for certain loans.
