



## CSHB 105(EDC)– Sex/Reproduction Education; Schools

### Sectional Analysis

33-GH1072\S

“An Act relating to parental rights in a child's education; relating to a child's names and pronouns; relating to access to school records; relating to school funding; relating to charter schools; relating to state boarding schools; relating to school disciplinary and safety programs; and providing for an effective date.”

#### **Section 1:**

Amends AS 14.03.016, *A parent's right to direct the education of the parent's child*, (a)(3) by requiring parents to receive notification not less than two weeks before any activity, class, or program is provided. This subsection also adds an “opt-in” provision stating that parents must provide written permission for their child to participate in the activity, class or program.

Additional language is added under (a)(7) requiring a parent to provide a list of names and pronouns that may be used to address the child to the school district for inclusion in their school record and procedures to change that provided list.

#### **Section 2:**

Amends AS 14.03.016, *A parent's right to direct the education of the parent's child*, by adding subsection (e), which further clarifies that the requirements in Section 1 of this bill do not include sexual assault awareness and prevention training required under AS 14.30.355, *Sexual abuse and sexual assault awareness and prevention*, nor dating violence and abuse awareness and prevention training required under AS 14.30.356, *Teen dating violence and abuse awareness and prevention program*.

#### **Section 3:**

Amends AS 14.03.115, *Access to school records by parent, foster parent, or guardian*, to require the school district to provide access to the entire school record for a child.

#### **Section 4:**

Amends AS 14.03.260, *Funding for charter school*, subsection (a) to include a parental involvement initiates funding factor for charter schools.

**Section 5:**

Amends AS 14.17.410(b)(1)(C) to include a parental involvements initiatives funding factor to the public school funding formula. This factor is applied after the vocational and technical instruction funding factor.

**Section 6:**

Amends AS 14.17.420(a) to include a parental involvements initiatives funding factor of 1.005 in the public school funding formula. The factor aims to provide funding to public schools for additional administrative and educational support for personnel and modifications of locker rooms and restroom facilities.

**Section 7:**

Amends AS 14.17.440(a) to include the parental involvement initiatives funding factor in the public school funding formula for state boarding schools.

**Section 8:**

Amends AS 14.33.120, *A parent's right to direct the education of the parent's child*, (a) by adding to the list of procedures required by school districts and regional educational attendance areas on addressing the physical safety and privacy of students in locker rooms and restrooms by providing access to single-occupancy facilities or other safety and privacy protocols consistent with AS 14.18.040.

**Section 9:**

Repeals AS 14.03.016(d)(2) which is amended into AS 14.03.016 subsection (e) above in Section 2 of this bill.

**Section 10:**

This bill is effective on July 1, 2023.
