BILL NO. HB 379

Analysis

This bill adds a reason for a person to be a restricted purchaser of alcoholic beverages under statute if they are under a driving-while-under-the-influence-diversion program.

If the bill is adopted, the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office will absorb related costs within its current authorized budget, and does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
