




WILLOW PROJECT LOCATION




OWNERSHIP/ROYALTY INTEREST

Federal Permitting History


- 2012/2013 NPR-A IAP ROD signed and alternative adopted Feb 2013
- 2018 Scoping for Willow Master Development Plan EIS Record of Decision (ROD) issued in October 2020
 - 2020 Willow Supplemental EIS (SEIS) completed in response to project changes sought by ConocoPhillips in response to community input
 - Lawsuits were immediately filed in federal court, and work was enjoined early 2021
 - In response to federal court remand, BLM initiated a second SEIS
- 2022 Scoping for 2nd Willow SEIS, with ROD issued March 2023
 - Lawsuits were immediately filed in federal court and are ongoing

Development Timeline

- Initial ice-construction underway
- Litigation ongoing State opposes preliminary injunction
- Project permitting continues
- Project final investment decision (FID) and sanction has not been approved by ConocoPhillips
- Potential construction to begin 2023 and continue, along with drilling, through 2027/2028/2029
