Source: Data is for claims with a paid date within the SFY 2022 (07/01/2021 - 06/30/2022). The source for claims processed by Behavioral Health's ASO are the Optum Alaska Reconciliation Detail Reports. All other claims were extracted from MMIS/COGNOS. Medicaid providers are allowed to submit claims up to one year after the date of service.

Split between State and Federal payment amounts was calculated based on the FMAP assigned to payment codes. Payment amounts are the net of all claims paid during the State Fiscal Year. Amounts do not reflect payments made outside of the two claims systems (such as lump sum payments, recoveries, or accounting adjustments) and may therefore not equal expenditure totals in the state accounting or budget systems.

Beneficiaries: Number of persons eligible for Medicaid and enrolled for at least one month during SFY 2022. Counts are unduplicated on the Medicaid member identification number. Demographic and enrollment information was obtained from the beneficiary's most recent enrollment information within the State Fiscal Year.

Recipients: Number of persons having Medicaid claims paid or adjusted during the SFY 2022 (service may have been incurred in a prior quarter). Demographic and enrollment information is obtained from the most recent claim for that recipient. Counts are unduplicated on the Medicaid member identification number.

Location (Region) categories are based on residence information (village coding) taken from the corresponding eligibility record. Recipient and claim payment statistics for unknown locations may be inflated due to the practice of retroactive eligibility
