1 PREVENTION SERVICES PLAN SUBMISSION. (a) The Department of Family and
2 Community Services shall contract with a third-party review agency to conduct a
3 comprehensive scan of all child welfare prevention programs in the state identified by the
4 United States Department of Health and Human Services, Children's Bureau. The scan must
5 include evaluation of any curriculum used by the program, staff qualifications and workloads,
6 targeted population identification, and methods of outreach, data collection, organizational
7 management and evaluation, and reporting procedures. The scan must be completed not later
8 than January 1, 2025.

9 (b) Not later than July 1, 2025, the Family First Prevention Services Team established
10 in AS 44.30.020(c), added by sec. 1 of this Act, shall submit to the United States Department
11 of Health and Human Services, Children's Bureau, a Family First Prevention Services Title
12 IV-E Prevention Plan for approval."
