FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

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Analysis

This bill allows educators who retire with a valid Alaska teaching certificate to receive, free of charge, a certificate that is good for life allowing the educator to work for up to 165 consecutive days in the State as a long-term substitute teacher. An applicability section is added stating that this Act applies to a contract or collective bargaining agreement that becomes legally binding on or after the effective date of this Act.

Each year, the Department of Education and Early Development’s Teacher Certification section processes an average of 100 retired teaching certifications. The processing fee for a retired teaching certificate is \$240 per certificate. If the Teacher Certification section processes 100 retired teaching certificates, this will result in an overall loss of \$24.0 in general fund/program receipts. In addition, a one-time cost of \$6.0 for legal fees is needed to implement necessary regulation changes associated with this legislation.
